Attached for your review is "Mphasis Dual Endpoints & the Forgotten QBE Laptop."

The document summarizes the operational sequence reflected in the record and identifies governance, endpoint-management, and access-control questions arising from that sequence.

Notably, your June 5 submission (ECF 558) seeks injunctive relief concerning conduct involving both Mphasis and QBE. That request appears consistent with the operational reality reflected in the record: the events at issue involved a dual-endpoint environment, a QBE-issued laptop, Mphasis workflow requirements, cybersecurity escalation, and governance questions extending beyond a single device or a single organization.

The attached paper does not attempt to restate legal arguments currently before the Court. Rather, it organizes the operational facts and governance questions reflected in the record, including infrastructure constraints, endpoint accountability, security escalation, operational reliance, and the unresolved circumstances surrounding the QBE-issued laptop.

As the document reflects, these issues would likely remain subjects of discovery, witness examination, and trial testimony if the matter proceeds.

My preference remains to resolve this dispute without additional litigation expense, further discovery, or the need for testimony from current and former employees, management personnel, information-security personnel, client representatives, or executive leadership.

To the extent meaningful settlement discussions remain possible, I remain willing to consider reasonable proposals that provide finality for all parties.
